

### EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM)

- 13 flights repatriated 1 510 people from Israel and Egypt.
- Greece delivered 1 000 shelter items to support Cyprus in case of refugee influx.
- 353 people evacuated by rescEU-facilitated bus from Gaza.
- 9 Member States (MS) and rescEU stock offered medical equipment, medicines and consumables to support Egypt's healthcare system.
- Spain offered one reverse osmosis unit for water treatment to ICRC field hospital in Gaza.
- Cyprus is establishing the UCPM logistics hub to facilitate aid via the CMC.
- WHO requested UCPM assistance for medical evacuations from Gaza to Europe. 6 MS offered transport and treatment to medically evacuate Palestinian patients.
- Food assistance shipped via the CMC and the US trident pier.

### European Humanitarian Response Capacity (EHRC)

- 55 flights landed (most recent flight on 20 June 2024).
- 2 690 tonnes of humanitarian relief items delivered either by air, sea or land.
- EHRC stockpile mechanism:
  - ✓ 161 tonnes of logistics items to Egypt and Palestine\*
  - ✓ 232 tonnes of WASH and shelter items
- 12 MS and 19 humanitarian aid partners supported.
- 168 tonnes transported via EU Convoy.
- 1 EU warehouse with ongoing rehabilitation works.

Since 7 October 2023, 1.7 million IDPs<sup>1</sup> in Gaza.

1.5 m<sup>2</sup> average space per person in IDP<sup>1</sup> shelters.

Approximately 100 000 households estimated in urgent need of shelter support.

### Expert deployments



- 2023: 2 experts and 6 ERCC Liaison Officers deployed in Egypt and Cyprus.
  - 2024: 21 medical experts deployed in Egypt in support to WHO.
- Since March, 6 experts and 13 ERCC staff deployed in Cyprus. The EU Civil Protection Team supports the delivery of humanitarian aid through the CMC.
