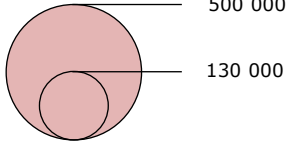


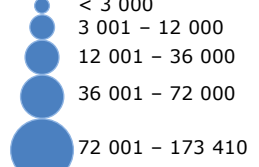

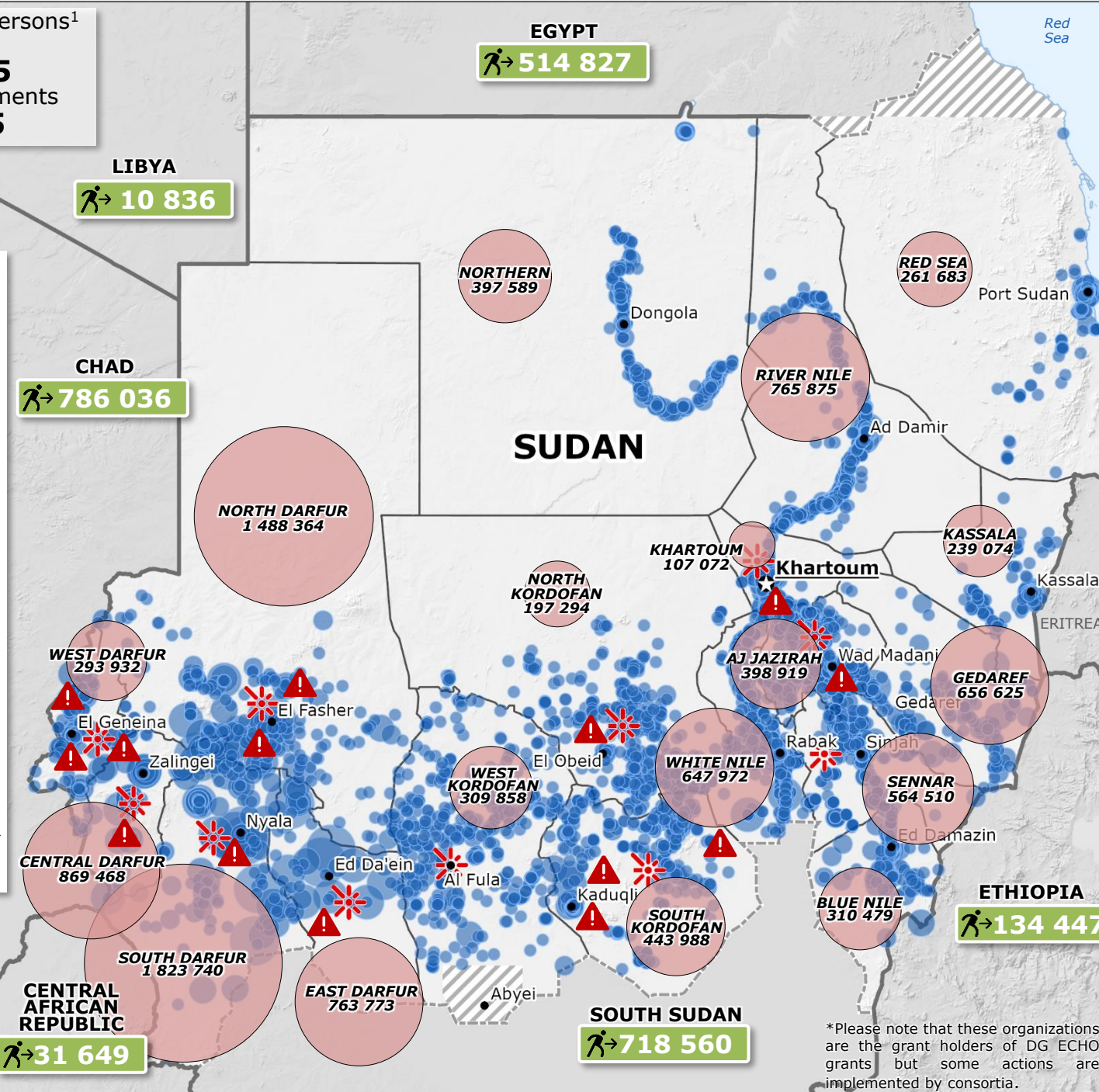
Population Flows

EUROPEAN HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE CAPACITY (EHRC)
2023: 8 flights to Port Sudan (167 tonnes of items transported); 5 flights to N'Djamena (474 tonnes transported); Atlas deployment Chad/Sudan border (May-Oct 2023); EU Humanitarian Flight Helicopter (HAF) in the east of Chad (Jul-Oct 2023).
2024: 5 flights to N'Djamena between 12/6-26/6 (over 271 tonnes transported).
