## **EU Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM)**

- WHO requested UCPM assistance for medical evacuations from Gaza to Europe. 8 Member States (MS) have offered transport and/or treatment to medically evacuate Palestinian patients. 36 patients and their 76 companions have been medically evacuated from Egypt to Spain, Belgium and Italy.
- A UCPM logistics hub was established in Cyprus to facilitate aid via the Cyprus Maritime Corridor (CMC). 4 MS/PS (Participating States) have channelled food, shelter and non-food items via this corridor.
- 9 MS and rescEU stock have provided medical equipment, medicines and consumables to support Egypt's healthcare system.
- Spain provided one reverse osmosis unit for water treatment to ICRC field hospital in Gaza.
- 353 people evacuated by rescEU-facilitated bus from Gaza.
- Greece delivered 1 000 shelter items to support Cyprus in case of refugee influx.
- 13 flights repatriated 1 510 people from Israel and Egypt.





### **European Humanitarian Response Capacity (EHRC)**

- 3 371 tonnes of humanitarian relief items transported by air, land or sea:
  - 59 flights with 2 661 tonnes
  - EU convoys with 289 tonnes
  - Maritime shipments with 366 tonnes
- EHRC stockpile (included above):
  - 279 tonnes of WaSH and shelter items
  - 195 tonnes of logistics items
- 12 MS and 23 humanitarian aid partners supported
- 3 logistics experts and 2 health experts deployed in Cairo and Amman, respectively
- 1 EU warehouse with ongoing rehabilitation works

# **UCPM** expert deployments

- 2023: 2 experts and 6 ERCC Liaison Officers deployed in Egypt and Cyprus.
- 2024: 33 deployments of medical experts in Egypt in support to WHO.
- Since March 2024, 6 MS experts and 16 ERCC Liaison Officers deployed in Cyprus, Egypt and Israel. The EU Civil Protection Team supports the delivery of humanitarian aid through the CMC.
