

# Russia's War on Ukraine | Generators and transformers offered to Ukraine



## Generators and Transformers

Offered 15 February 2022 – 14 November 2024 (12:00 UTC)



**31 countries** (25 EU Member States and 6 UCPM<sup>1</sup> Participating States) provided energy supplies



In total, **8 432 power generators** were offered to Ukraine **under the UCPM**, of which **5 068** were offered by 24 Member States and 2 UCPM<sup>1</sup> Participating States, with an estimated **1 230 296 kVA** in power generators



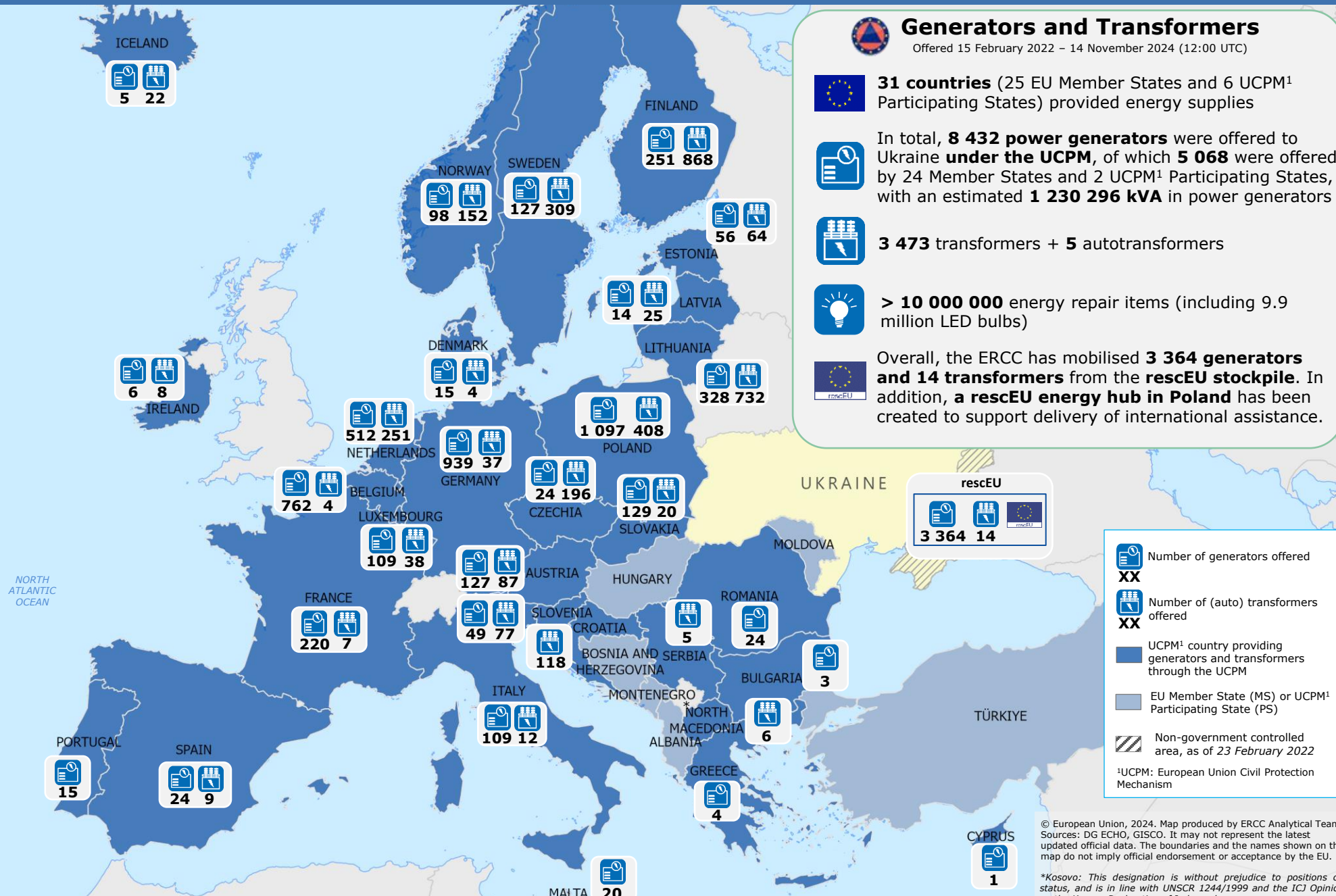
**3 473 transformers + 5 autotransformers**



**> 10 000 000** energy repair items (including 9.9 million LED bulbs)



Overall, the ERCC has mobilised **3 364 generators and 14 transformers** from the **rescEU stockpile**. In addition, a **rescEU energy hub in Poland** has been created to support delivery of international assistance.
