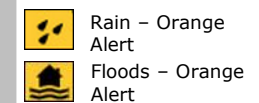


## SITUATION

- Heavy rain affected South and South West of France on 28 and 29 September causing floods. 1 030 Fire Fighters have been deployed in the operations.
- Approximately 4 000 people including 1 600 children are affected. 300 people have been evacuated from the flooded streets in the department of Hérault, 400 people were blocked in Montpellier airport and 2 000 blocked in several railway stations.
- The situation is improving. On 30 September, 7.00 UTC, operations were ongoing in four departments.
- As of 30 September, an orange alert is issued for Vidourle and Lez rivers indicating risk of flood-generating large spills that could have a significant impact on community life and the safety of property and people.
