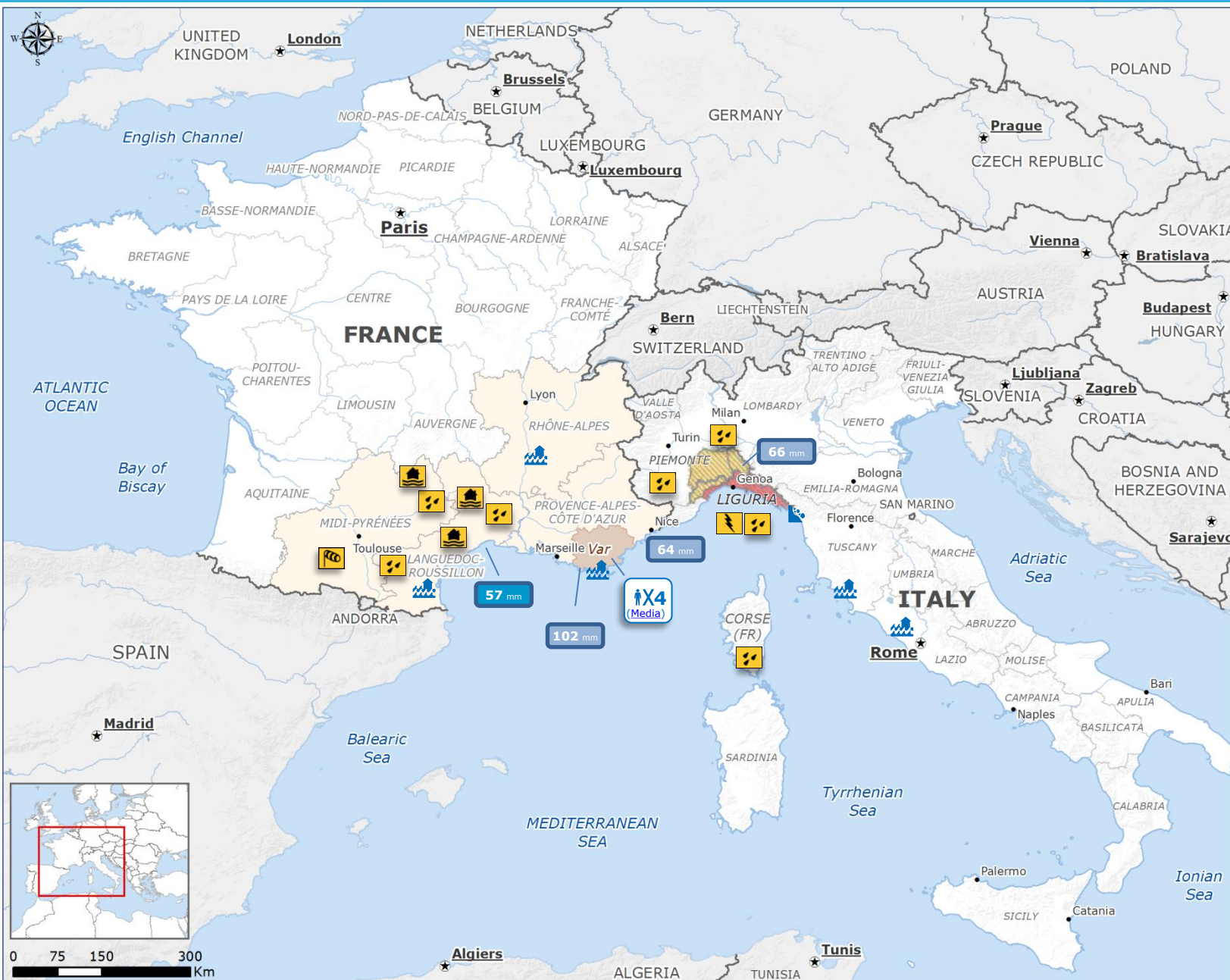


# 28 November 2014: Europe - Severe Weather



## SITUATION

- Heavy rains and winds continued affecting parts of southern France, as well as parts of Italy, in the last few days, causing floods and landslides.
- In **France**, heavy rain caused flash floods in southern parts of the country on 27-28 November, killing four people in the department of Var, Provence-Alpes-Côte d'Azur region (as of 28 November, [media](#)) and causing power outages for approx. 6 000 houses in the Ardèche department (Rhône-Alpes regions). On 25-26 November several people were also evacuated in Hyères (Var department).
- In **Italy**, heavy rain caused the blockage of roads due to overflow rivers in the province of Rome (Lazio) and floods in the province of Grosseto (Tuscany). A Red Alert for landslide risk is in effect, by the Civil Protection, for the Region of Liguria, as of 28 November. The Copernicus Emergency Management Service was activated on 25 November by the Italian Civil Protection for the area of Genoa (Liguria). Heavy rains may still affect northern Italy in the next 24 h.
