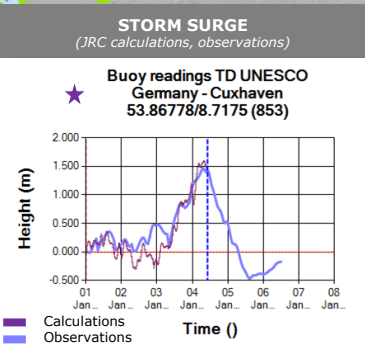
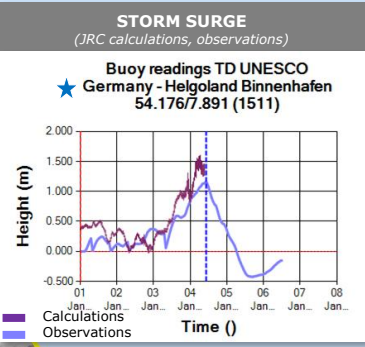


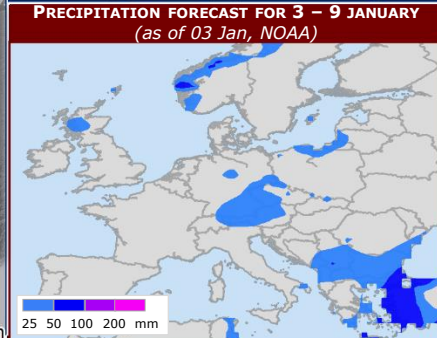
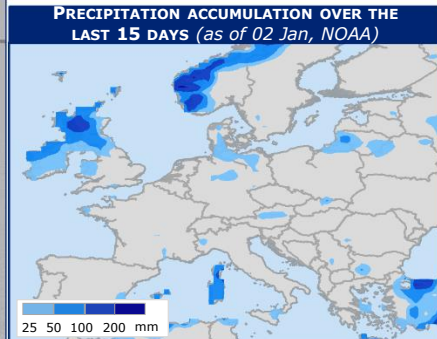
The Danish metrological office has issued a **warning for high water levels** in south-eastern Denmark. It has also issued a very dangerous warning for Fyn county, hazardous weather warning for Storstrøms, Roskilde, København



### SITUATION

- Severe weather conditions (strong winds, snowfall, storm surge, thunderstorms) are affecting Central and Eastern Europe. As of 4 January, several Meteoalarm – Orange and Red Alerts are still in effect in Europe (see map).
- Extreme cold weather is to prevail over east Scandinavia, Eastern and Central Europe and the Balkans during the next days due to a significant outbreak of arctic air masses spreading southern with locally intense snowfalls. This cold outbreak is expected to last till Sunday (8 January). Minimum temperatures 15 to 20°C below average values for this time of year are expected over areas affected by arctic masses (mainly Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Poland, Czech Republic, Austria).
