

## SITUATION

- On 21 August, a little after 18h00 UTC, Typhoon TRAMI made landfall in the coastal area near the city of Fuzhou in **China**. Its max sustained wind speed was 138km/h. After landfall, it moved W, over **Fujian** province, weakening. In the following 24h, it was forecast to move W over **Fujian** and **Jianxi**, eventually weakening into a Tropical Depression.
- TRAMI has been affecting the areas along its path with heavy rainfall and strong winds and it is expected to continue affecting SE China in the next 24h. As of 22 August, a Yellow Typhoon Warning was still in effect.
- The passage of TRAMI off the northern coast of **Taiwan**, affected the island with heavy rainfall and consequent landslides. As of 22 August, local media report ca. 1,400 evacuated from the northern provinces.
- In the **Philippines**, as of 22 August, the number of casualties due to heavy rainfall, floods and landslides in the past few days in **Luzon**, reported by the NDRRMC, has risen to 16 dead and five missing, while the affected population has exceeded 1 250 000, 193 777 of which were sheltered in 590 evacuation centres. Heavy rainfall continued on 21 August in **Luzon**. As of 22 August, for the following hours, the weather forecast by PAGASA mentioned mostly light to moderate rain and there were no Warnings in effect.
