



SITUATION OVERVIEW

- According to **Vigicrues** and **Copernicus EFAS**, water levels are decreasing in the **Yonne** and the **Seine** rivers but are likely to increase slightly due to the forecasted precipitation over the coming days. **The peak of the flood is expected over 27-28 Jan.** and it will reach similar or slightly higher water levels than the Seine Floods 2016.
- 395** people evacuated, several roads flooded and one line of commuter train in Paris has been affected.
