

# Iran | Floods wrap-up March-April

- 16,3 Million** affected, in 28 out of 31 provinces (OCHA)
- > 500 000** displaced (IFRC)
- 3 million** in need of health care (Ministry of Health and Medical Education)
- CHF 5,1 million** (EUR 4,5 million) emergency appeal (IFRC)
- 2 Million** in need of immediate humanitarian assistance
- 78** fatalities (OCHA)
- At least 94** emergency camps in 5 most affected provinces (IRCS)
- USD 1 bn** (EUR 891,7 million) damage to agriculture, infrastructure and historical places (NDMA)

On 8 April, the EU Civil Protection Mechanism (EUCPM) was activated following a request for assistance from the Iranian authorities. The European Commission has provided humanitarian funding of EUR 1.2 million to assist the response.

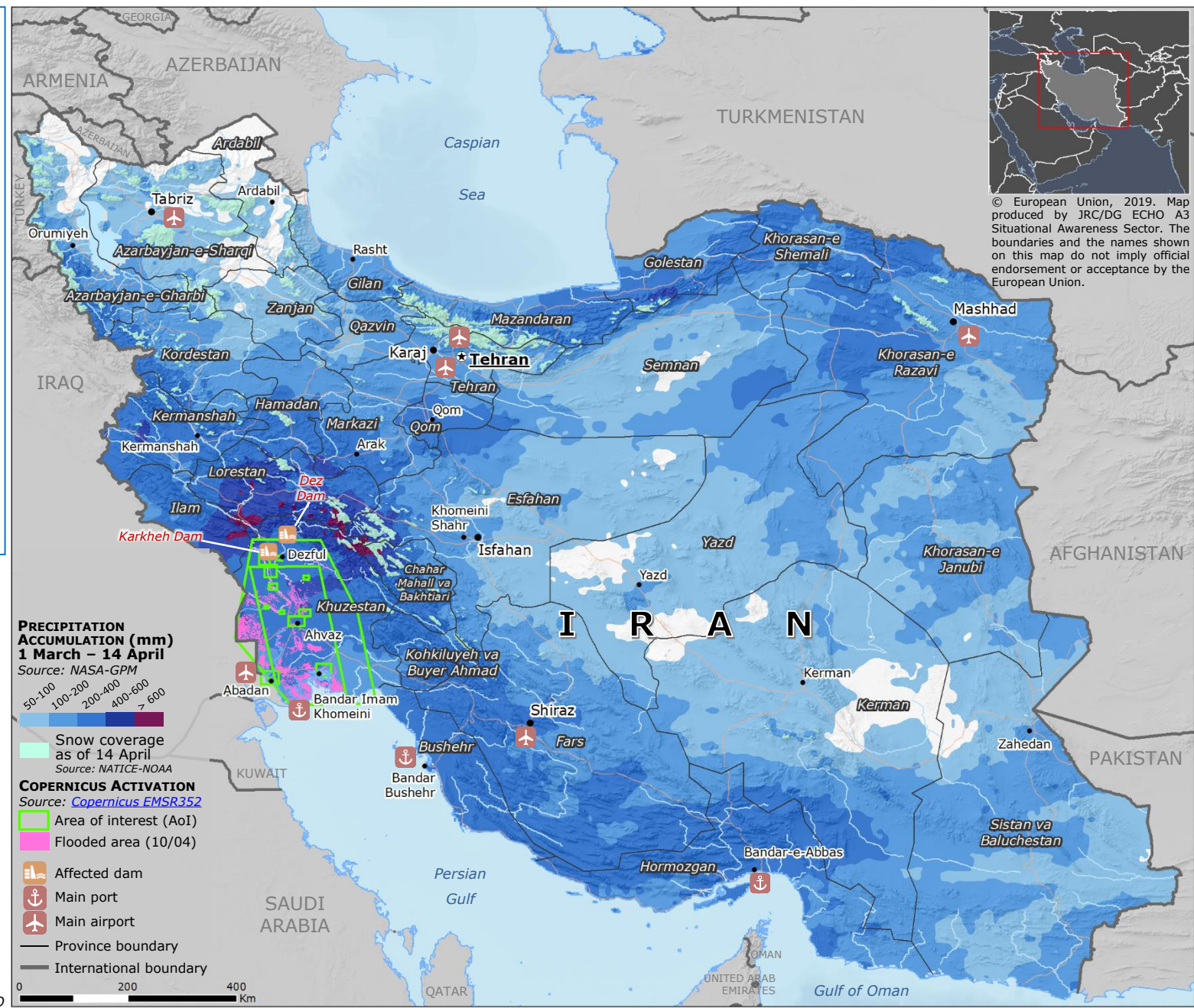
Austria, Czech Republic, France, Italy, Slovakia and Turkey have made offers through the EUCPM: medical, hygiene, shelter (e.g. tents, plastic rolls), utility (e.g. generators, boats, solar lamps, water pumps and water tanks).

The in-kind assistance was delivered to the Iranian Red Crescent Society for further distribution of the relief items.

An ERCC Liaison Officer deployed to Tehran, 23-27 April, to coordinate the assistance provided through the EUCPM.
