

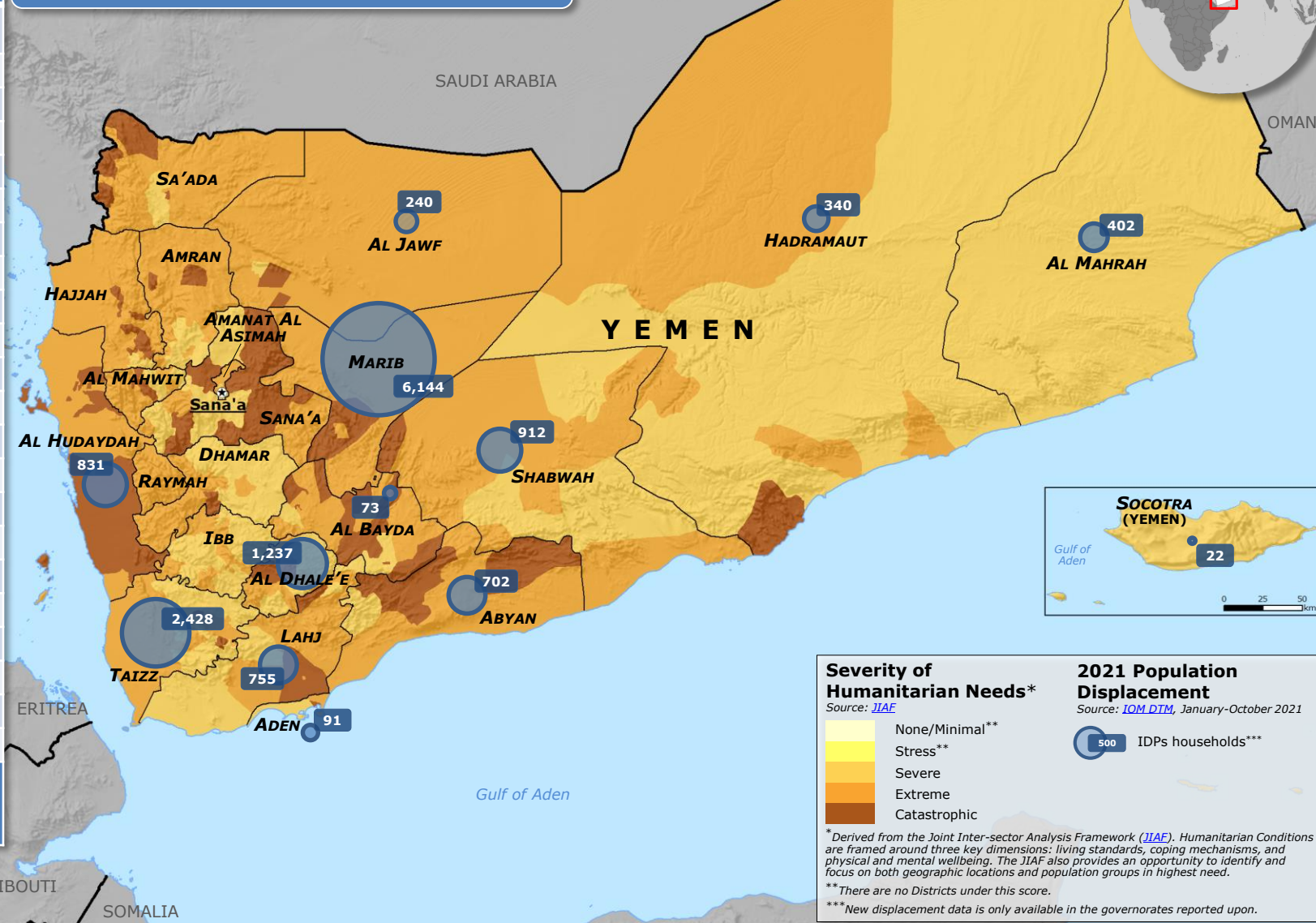

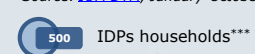
### Severity of Humanitarian Needs\*
